The **OECD** declaration defines innovation as the implementation of novel techniques to a certain context in order to achieve impact; it is a proactive strategy that governments can use to respond to, adapt to and prepare for a variety of challenges, such as digital transformation, energy poverty, environmental degradation, climate change and inequality.

Innovation recognizes the ineffectiveness of the old way of doing business. In the context of the public sector, there is an urgent need for innovative responses to the current and emerging challenges.

In this context, the Observatory of Public Sector Innovation (OPSI), a flagship initiative of the OECD, works to encourage innovation and detect emerging public sector trends and practices around the world; accompany governments in addressing their policy problems; conducting case studies, evaluations and reviews of various innovation practices around the world.

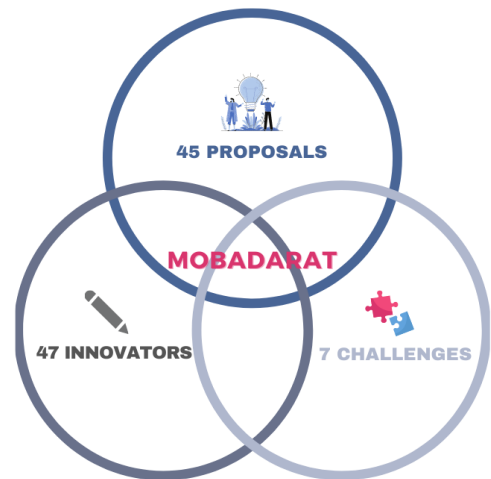
## BENCHMARKING INNOVATION WORLDWIDE

## OPEN INNOVATION AGAINST COVID-19



Mobadarat.ma was born in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic. When building the Mobadarat platform, Impact For Development, in partnership with the School of Collective Intelligence of University Mohammed VI Polytechnique and Al Akhawayn University, aimed to create a space where the community's collective intelligence can be utilized to address the effects of COVID-19 in Morocco.

Mobadarat.ma unites various stakeholders and offers them a forum to collectively and proactively share ideas to tackle the challenges in hand. In this sense, the platform is also used as an innovative tool to collect and publish lessons learned, which in turn enables cross learning and knowledge exchange. This feature is also present in the OECD Observatory of Public Sector Innovation.
